It would be impossible to mention New Farm and not think of the iconic New Farm Park. Originally farming land for the convict workers of the area, today the park is a favourite weekend destination for many. Offering sports fields, rose gardens, play equipment, barbecues and a vast area of space to sit and soak up the sun, a trip to this green oasis reveals picnicking couples and new families co-existing peacefully with groups of teenagers and backpackers.

New Farm has gone through many different phases in her coming of age, perhaps the grungiest of these made famous in Andrew McGahan's novel, *Praise*. Known now for a more prestigious crowd than in the 1980s, New Farm has come into its own as a centre for shopping, eating and the arts. Perhaps most noticeable is

Brisbane Powerhouse, an old power station that has been transformed into a modern centre of the arts.

Just next door to New Farm sits Teneriffe, a suburb that has recently undergone a residential boom. Walking along the streets, you can still see the old woolstores preserved in their original glory, though most of the warehouses have been converted into stylish apartment complexes, complete with cafes and restaurants below. Stroll along the riverwalk that fringes the suburb and you will capture some of the best views of the Brisbane River. You'll also find a burgeoning dining scene along the Teneriffe strip, featuring international cuisine, wine bars, and a sleek neighbourhood grocer that has become the locals' favourite.
